### ...HELMET HINTS...



Give your helmet a treat by using your beeswax leather conditioner which came with the helmet kit. Remove dust, place a small quantity onto a polishing cloth and apply evenly. Allow to dry before polishing...this reconditions the leather and will keep your leather looking good and lasting longer. Make the process easier by removing the goggles first, and if the lenses need cleaning use hot soapy water and/or polycarbonate cleaner.
